Temporary Closure - November

The Pooch Park is temporarily closed until Monday, December 2 for biannual turf maintenance and resting period. This yearly scheduled maintenance is to ensure the turf remains healthy. The City's landscape contractor will remove weed grasses and aerate the turf. Aeration is the process of coring holes into the turf so oxygen, water, and nutrients can penetrate the soil. It also breaks up soil that has become compacted and hardened due to heavy use. These routine maintenance activities allow for the turf to remain healthy and vibrant during the warmer months. <u>More...</u>
